Eddy asked County Auditor if she has received any written or oral comments and Groen confirmed she has not received any written or oral comments. Groen explained the Ordinance No. 13 was the previous election precincts and that Ordinance 14 precinct descriptions were also presented during the December 22, 2021, public hearing to consider 2020 census precinct boundary changes. With no additional comments or discussion, motioned by Barnett and second by Heidenwirth to close the public hearing. All ayes. Motion carried. Motioned by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to adopt the considered Ordinance Title 1, No. 14. All ayes. Motioned carried. The roll was called and the vote was: AYES: Barnett, Heidenwirth, Eddy. BUTLER COUNTY ORDINANCE TITLE I, NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 13 AND ESTABLISHING BUTLER COUNTY ELECTION PRECINCTS

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose: The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal totally Ordinance No. 13 and establish election precincts effective January15, 2022, in accordance with Iowa Code Sections 331.210A and 49.7 of the Code of Iowa

Section 2. Boundaries of Election Precincts: Butler County shall have eight (8) election precincts whose boundaries shall be as follows:

- 1 GR: Bennezette Township, including the City of Aredale; Coldwater Township, including the City of Greene; and the part of Dayton Township lying West of Packard Avenue, and North of Range Road and 140th Street (All Dayton Township excluding Sections 36, 35, 34, 27, 26, 25, approx. S $\frac{1}{4}$ of 22)
- 2 CL: Fremont Township; Butler Township, including the City of Clarksville; Jackson Township, excluding the City of Allison; and that part of Dayton Township lying East of Packard Ave and South of Range Road and 140th Street (Sections 36, 35, 34, 27, 26, 25, approx. S ½ 22).
- 3 DU: Pittsford Township, including the City of Dumont, but excluding the City of Bristow, Madison Township, and Washington Township
- 4 AL: West Point Township, including the City of Bristow and the City of Allison; and Ripley Township
- 5 AP: Monroe Township, including the City of Aplington, but excluding the City of Parkersburg
- 6 SR: Jefferson Township, Shell Rock Township, including the City of Shell Rock; that part of Albion Township lying North of 305Th Street and East of Ridge Avenue to intersection of 290th; and that part North of 290th St and East of Quail Avenue (Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, N $\frac{1}{2}$ of 13); and that part of Beaver Township lying North of 310th Street and North of 305th Street (Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, N $\frac{1}{2}$ 18).
- 7 PB: That part of Albion Township lying South of 305th Street; West of Ridge Ave to the intersection of 290th, and also West of Quail Avenue (All Albion excluding Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, N $\frac{1}{2}$ of 13), including the City of Parkersburg.
- 8 NH: That part of Beaver Township lying South of 310th Street and South of 305th Street, including the City of New Hartford.

Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance shall be effective on January 15, 2022, after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
