

**MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON FEBRUARY 6, 2024.**

Meeting called to order at 9:02 A.M. by Chairman Wayne Dralle with members Rusty Eddy and Greg Barnett present. Moved by Barnett second by Eddy to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motioned by Barnett, second by Eddy to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried.

No public comment was received.

Motioned by Eddy, second by Barnett to open a Second Public Hearing on a request by Jeremy Cole, Cole Excavating to rezone 8.2 acres from A-1 to C to relocate business shop/headquarters to a parcel described as that part of Lot 16N1/2 NW W of RD & N 295.3' lot 17 W of RD of Section 1, Township 93 North, Range 17 West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. With no additional comments, motioned by Eddy, second by Barnett to close the Public Hearing. All ayes. Motion carried.

Board considered Ordinance Title VI, Number 33 – An Ordinance Amending the Official Zoning Map. Motioned by Barnett, second by Eddy to approve the second reading and waive the third hearing. All ayes. Motion carried and Ordinance Title VI, Number 33 was adopted as follows:

**ORDINANCE TITLE VI, NUMBER 33**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP, WHICH IS CONSIDERED PART OF BUTLER COUNTY, IOWA ZONING ORDINANCE (ORDINANCE TITLE VI, NUMBER 28, ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 1, 2022)**

**Section 1. RESCISSION.** This Ordinance rescinds the current zoning designation, “A-1” Agriculture, on a parcel legally described as follows:

A tract of land described as all that part of Lot 16 of Auditor’s Highland Plat, a subdivision of the north part of the Northwest Fractional Quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of Section One (1), Township Ninety-three (93) North, Range Seventeen (17) West of the 5<sup>th</sup> P.M., lying South and West of Highland Drive, AND A tract beginning at the intersection of the center of Highland Drive and Eldred Avenue, thence South 295.3 feet, thence westerly at an internal angle of 94°10’ a distance of 521.5 feet to the right-of-way of the Chicago, Rock Island and Pacific Railway, thence northwest along said right of way to the west line of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 1, Township 93, Range 17, thence north to the south line of Lot 16 of said Auditor’s Highland Plat, thence east along said south line of Lot 16 to the point of beginning, EXCEPT the following:

1. The land described by Warranty Deed dated September 14, 1964, and filed on September 25, 1964, in Book 94, page 84, to Darrell Davis and Sadie M. Davis;
2. The land described by Quit Claim Deed dated October 15, 1966, and filed on October 19, 1966, in Book 96, page 265, to State of Iowa; and
3. The land described by Warranty Deed and Easement dated October 15, 1966, and filed on October 19, 1966, in Book 96, page 268, to State of Iowa.

on the Official Zoning Map as was originally adopted.

**Section 2. ADOPTION.** This Ordinance adopts in lieu thereof a new zoning designation “C” for the property legally described above, on the Official Zoning Map.

**Section 3. INTEGRATION WITH CODE.** Each section, provision or part of this Ordinance which is followed by a section number shall be inserted in the Butler County Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. Title VI, Number 28, adopted on November 1, 2022) as indicated by said section number and hereafter shall be cited by reference to said section number.

**Section 4. REPEALER.** All ordinances and resolutions, parts thereof or amendments thereto, in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5. SEVERABILITY OF REPEALER.** All ordinances and resolutions, parts thereof or amendments thereto, not directly affected by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 6. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such section, provision, or part shall be severable from the rest of the Ordinance, and such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

**Section 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its final passage and publication as provided by law.

RESOLUTION 1095-2024**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO SIGN AND THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO ATTEST TO THE TWO-MILE FRINGE AREA POLICY AGREEMENT BETWEEN BUTLER COUNTY, IOWA; GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA; AND THE CITY OF PARKERSBURG, IOWA ESTABLISHING POLICIES FOR DEVELOPMENT OF LAND WITHIN THE TWO-MILE EXTRATERRITORIAL AREA OF PARKERSBURG WITHIN BUTLER COUNTY.

WHEREAS, two (2) or more local governments enabled under Section 354.9 and Chapter 28E of the Code of Iowa to enter into agreements to cooperate for the mutual advantage of the governments involved; and

WHEREAS, Butler County deems a land use policy agreement with the City of Parkersburg for orderly growth and development within the two (2) mile extraterritorial jurisdiction of Parkersburg within Butler and Grundy Counties, to be to the mutual advantage of Parkersburg, Butler County, and Grundy County.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Butler County hereby authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign and the County Auditor to attest to the attached 28E Agreement between Butler County, Grundy County, and the City of Parkersburg establishing land use policies for the two (2) mile extraterritorial jurisdiction of Parkersburg in Butler County.

- Sheriff Funding request – Jason Johnson, Sheriff, discussed a few budget items including salary increases, vehicles, equipment, and software.
- FY25 Budget Review and discussion – Leslie Groen, Auditor, explained the budget changes she made and again shared how HF718 has changed the County’s FY25 budgeting process, specifically sharing the levy changes for General Basic and how we are held to last year’s levy of \$3.63 based on a calculated taxable growth factor. Groen has been working with other County Auditors to research options. Multiple line items and future salaries were discussed.

Board considered Resolution of Support of 28E Agreement for RAISE grant application. John Riherd, Engineer, explained the grant which is bundled with seven other counties. Butler County is the lead agent on the grant application. Motioned by Barnett, second by Eddy to approve the Grant Application. Roll call: Ayes – Eddy, Dralle, Barnett.
