MINUTES AND PROCEEDINGS OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BUTLER COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HELD ON June 30, 2021.

With social distancing guidelines being maintained at in-person meetings, an electronic participation option is made available. This complies with lowa Code section 21.8 that outlines the guidelines to hold an electronic meeting when there are valid concerns that an in-person meeting is "impossible or impractical".

Meeting called to order at 9:00 A.M. by Chairman Greg Barnett with members Rusty Eddy and Tom Heidenwirth present. Moved by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy to approve the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read. Motioned by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy to approve the minutes as read. All ayes. Motion carried.

During public comment County Auditor, Leslie Groen, mentioned the FY20 audit report was published last week. Barnett asked about removing the social distancing guidelines and meeting reservations and Groen will check with Public Health Director, Jennifer Becker. Eddy also asked about moving the board meetings back to the board room and Groen will check into that ask well.

County Conservation Director, Mike Miner, explained the Conservation transfer request was for camping fees revenue that exceeded the authorized amount of \$75,000 due to an increase in camping fees this past year. Motioned by Eddy, second by Heidenwirth to authorize Auditor to transfer the additional \$6,708.68 from FY21 revenue to the Conservation Reserve Account. All ayes. Motion carried.

County Engineer, John Riherd, provided details for three projects in the Logistics Park Urban Renewal Area and the costs associated with the transfer request. The projects included Union Ave paving, C55 hot-in-place recycling, and a portion of Sinclair Ave earth shouldering. Motioned by Barnett, second by Heidenwirth to authorize the Auditor to transfer \$1,255,645 from Capital Projects to Secondary Roads. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motioned by Heidenwirth, second by Eddy adopt Resolution for Fiscal Year 2022 Appropriations as follows:

In accordance with section 331.437, Code of Iowa, no department or officer shall expend or contract to expend any money or incur any liability, or enter into any contract which by its terms involves the expenditure of money for any purpose in excess of the amount appropriated pursuant to this resolution.

Section 4. If any time during the 2021-2022 budget year the auditor shall ascertain that the available resources of a fund for that year will be less than said fund's total appropriations, she shall immediately so inform the board and recommend appropriate corrective action.

Section 5. The auditor shall establish separate accounts for the appropriations authorized in section 1, each of which account shall indicate the amount of the appropriation, the amount charged thereto and the unencumbered balance. The auditor shall report the status of such accounts to the applicable departments and officers monthly during the 2021-2022 budget year.

Section 6. All appropriations authorized pursuant to this resolution lapse at the close of business June 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, it is desired to authorize the auditor to periodically transfer sums from the general basic and rural services basic funds to the secondary road fund during the 2021/2022 budget year, and

WHEREAS, said transfers must be in accordance with section 331.429, Code of Iowa, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Butler County, Iowa as follows:

Section 1. The total maximum transfer from the general basic fund to the secondary road fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, shall not exceed the sum of \$150,000.00; and the total maximum transfer from the rural services basic fund to the secondary road fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, shall not exceed the sum of \$1,850,000.00.

Section 2. After being notified of the apportionment of current property taxes, mobile home taxes, military service tax credit, or delinquent taxes paid for prior years to the general basic or rural services basic fund, the auditor shall order a transfer from said fund to secondary road fund.

Section 3. The amount of the transfer required by section 2 shall be equal to the apportionment made under section 2, to the general basic or rural services basic fund, respectively, multiplied by the ratio of said fund's total maximum transfer to the secondary road fund, to the sum of said fund's total current property tax levy, total mobile home taxes, total military service tax credits, and total delinquent taxes paid for prior years.

Section 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 and 3 of this resolution, total transfers to the secondary road fund shall not exceed the amount specified in section 1.

Section 5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 2 and 3, the amount of any transfer shall not exceed available funds balances in the transferring fund.

Section 6. The auditor is directed to correct her books when said operating transfers are made and to notify the treasurer and the county engineer of the amount of said transfers.
