## **REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR COURT APPOINTED ATTORNEYS**

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature set reasonable compensation for court appointed attorneys, for all juvenile and criminal cases not involving felony criminal charges, at \$66.00 per hour.

WHEREAS, Butler County is required by statute to pay for attorneys appointed for cases other than juvenile and criminal.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of Butler County to set a court appointed attorney fee schedule, in situations where the County may be held responsible for these costs, to be consistent with the updated version of Iowa Code section 815.7.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the reasonable compensation for Court appointed attorneys shall be set at \$66.00 per hour for court appointed attorneys to represent any person pursuant to Iowa Code section 814.11, 815.10 or other provision of Iowa Iaw.

County Engineer, John Riherd, explained each year bridge inspections are completed and introduced Resolution 1003 to take specific action on four bridges in the county. Barnett mentioned he would like to have some notification to residents in that area of the one bridge being closed and Riherd said he would try to do some notifications. Riherd provided detailed information regarding each bridge's location, each bridge's existing structure, an approximate replacement cost, and the signage that will be posted at each. WHEREAS, The Butler County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Code of Iowa to impose weight limitations on highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS, recent periodic inspections conforming to National Bridge Inspection Standards and Federal Highway Administration rules have been performed, and

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration rules require that bridges be reviewed and analyzed for Special Haul Vehicle configurations, and

WHEREAS, the results of these inspections and reviews indicate that the following structures have reduced load carrying capability and require load restrictions and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Butler County Board of Supervisors that these structures be posted with the following signs indicating each bridge's respective load limits.

Bridge C13T10 – FHWA # 89660 – located in Section 13 T93N R17W, Cold Water Twp ... Post with "Bridge Closed" signs

Bridge K18W10 – FHWA # 87905 – located on the west line of Section 18 T91N R17W, Ripley Twp ... Post with "Weight Limit 3 Tons", "One Lane", and "All Vehicles" signs

Bridge K22W10 – FHWA # 87930 – located on the west line of Section 22 T91N R17W, Ripley Twp ... Post with "Weight Limit Truck Series 15T, 25T, 25T", "One Lane", and "All Vehicles" signs

Bridge M28W10 - FHWA # 87370 - located on the west line of Section 28 T90N R18W, Washington Twp

Post with "Weight Limit Truck Series 9T, 15T, 15T", "One Lane", and "All Vehicles" signs
